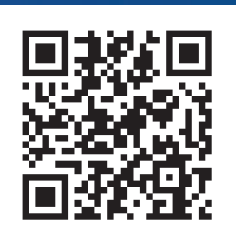

Information required for your appeal:

- Full name and home address
- Legal address and name of the organization/ official person, actions (lack of actions) are challenged
- Actions (lack of actions) or decisions that violate human and citizen rights
- Copies of decisions taken by local government or government authorities

Deadline for a complaint: Not later than one year from the date of the violation of rights and freedoms or from the day when it became known about rights violation.

Legal framework of the Ombudsman's activity in Perm region

The Ombudsman is guided by the Constitution of the Russian Federation, laws and other normative acts of the Russian Federation and the Perm region, as well as generally recognized principles and norms of the international law, international treaties to which the Russian Federation is a party.

Independence of the Ombudsman

The Ombudsman carries out his work independently and is not accountable to state and local authorities.

Any interference in the work of the Ombudsman is prohibited.

Any attempts to influence the decisions of the Ombudsman by interfering into his work, failures of state officials or local Perm region authorities to execute their duties under the legislation, as well as impeding the Ombudsman's work in any other way are punishable by the legislation of the Russian Federation and Perm region.

Legal framework of the Ombudsman's activity in Perm region



Redress for victims of human rights and freedoms violations



Taking measures to improve the legislation regarding the protection of human rights or the alignment of this legislation with the universally recognized principles and rules of international law



Facilitation of the monitoring of human rights observance in the territory of the Perm region by state and local authorities



Educational activities, promoting the dissemination of knowledge about human rights and freedoms, forms and methods of human rights protection



Promotion of the international cooperation on human rights



Assistance to public authorities and other state bodies in creating the conditions for the development of civil society.

The Ombudsman's actions during the examination of a complaint

- Requesting state and local authorities to provide the information necessary to look into a complaint
- Requesting for a written explanation by the authorities
- Initiating public control
- Providing recommendations and organizing the resolving of the conflict within the framework of the current legislation
- Sending an opinion to state or local authorities and officials to bring disciplinary or administrative proceedings or to open criminal cases
- Publishing the results of the resolving of a human rights violation complaint
- Making a report at the Legislative Assembly of the Perm region
- Demanding the establishment of a commission to investigate cases of human rights violations and hold special hearings with the participation of the Ombudsman.

Everyone has a right to:

- ◆ liberty and security of person
- ◆ protection against cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment

- ◆ appeal against the judgement of a superior court, presumption of innocence
- ◆ nationality, usage of his/her native language
- ◆ free travel, choice of place of stay or residence
- ◆ freedom of ideas and speech
